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
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NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENTS


A permit application for the mill and paving of the streets has been submitted to the City of Weston. The City is reviewing the documents and drawings, and we anticipate their approval shortly.

You may have noticed orange markings on damaged sidewalks throughout the neighborhood. The Association has filed a permit to replace these slabs. The sidewalk repairs will coincide with the first phase of the street project before installing new asphalt.

Ficus hedge replacement has begun. The landscaping upgrades will improve the aesthetics of common areas and guard against pest and plant disease.




NEW VISITOR MANAGEMENT SYSTEM



The Association is reviewing the advantages of a new entry system. It will enable residents to use their smart-phone to allow visitors to enter the property via a "Fast Access Pass."

Several neighboring communities already use this product, and their residents have expressed favorable reviews. In addition, this visitor management system is cloud-based and would make it easier for residents to control their visitor list.



It's Spring and the start of the growing season in South Florida. According to the Florida Department of Environmental Practices, a healthy-looking yard increases the value of your property, cools the air, and reduces glare, noise, and soil erosion.

The soil in our community is so nutrient-poor that fertilizer is necessary to maintain the healthy appearance of landscaping. Fertilize everything in your yard: lawn, shrubs, and especially your palm trees.

Schedule the first fertilizer application for March, followed by additional applications in June and October to preserve the trees and promote healthy growth. Consult your landscaper regarding best yard management practices.
